March 13<sup>th</sup>: Aryeh Green, Director of Media Central, Israel, will deliver the lecture following services.

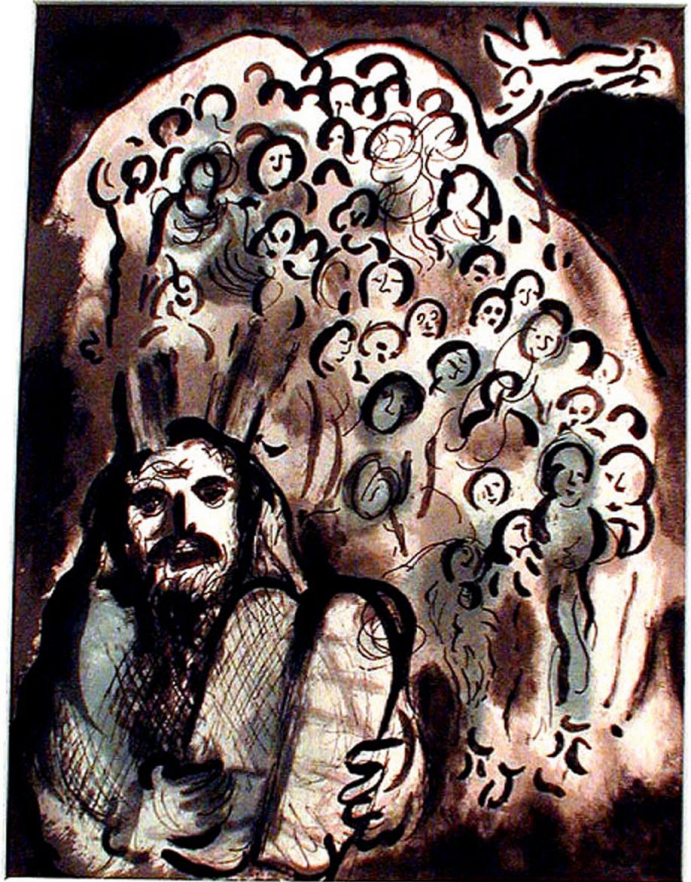
March 20<sup>th</sup>: Rabbi David Silber, Founder and Dean of the Drisha Institute for Jewish Education, will deliver the lecture following services.
